Elias Blackburn Junr. is appointed overseer of the road from Daniel's Mill to the three Notch'd [Road?]. Ordered that John Pickett, James Pickett, George Greens, Mary Williams, Thomas Mays, Samuel Boudry and Mace Pickett's people assist him in clearing the road.

Mary Binion being admitted to choose a guardian made choice of John Murrill. John Murrill with Wm. Binion his security acknowledged bond.

John Young is admitted guardian to Jerusa Hurt and also assigned guardian to Anna and Philemon Hurt. John Young with Edmond Pendleton Gent., his security, acknowledged bond.

John Partlow's deed of gift to his son John Partlow was proved by Wm. Oliver and Edward Baber.

John Newport vs. John Terrell. Pleas before the justices 14 November 20 George II [1746].

John Newport obtained an attachment from Thomas Johnson, Gent., one of his Majesty's justices, against the estate of John Terrell for £26.14.6 current money 9 Nov. 1743. John Taylor, Sheriff, returned by Jo[] Pickett his under sheriff that he had levied the attachment in the hands of John Woolfolk. The plaintiff by Zachary Lewis his attorney; Manoah Chiles [for the defendant?] [The defendant refuses to pay] to the damage of the plaintiff £40 current money.

[Continued] 11 May 1744

13 July, 10 August, 10 November [etc.] Jury find for the plaintiff [] current] money and 134 pounds of tobacco

[] vs. [] June 1746 came the parties by their attorneys [and state] in 1738 the defendant purchased a tract of land of Za[chary Martin and] gave Martin a writing that he would pay the debts then due from [] to] Turnbull a factor for John Willson, Patrick Barclay and William Marshall.

It is considered by the Court the plaintiff take nothing. Appealed to the 10th day of the next [General Court]

At a Court held 13 February 1746 [1747]

Present: William Woodford, John Taliaferro, Thomas Buckner, Wm. Taliaferro, Gent., justices.

It's ordered the road Joseph Woolfolk petitioned for have turned stand according to the viewers" report.

Wm. Beverley Gent. acknowledged his deed of land indenture to Robert Gilchrist.

Present: Robert Farish, Gent.

It's ordered Rice Curtis, Roger Quarles and Richard Murry settle an account of the administration of the estate of John Riddle.

Present: Thomas Johnson and Richd. Buckner, Gent.

Thomas Buckner, James Taylor and George Hoomes, Gent., are nominated for sheriff.

Robert Dawson is appointed constable of the precinct in which Charles Benson is constable.

It's ordered the Sheriff summon the children of Wm. Lee, deceased, to appear next Court.

Present: George Hoomes, Gent.

George Wyth Gent. produced a license to plead as an attorney, took the oaths, subscribed the Test, was sworn.

On the motion of Edmond Pendleton Gent., Churchwarden of Drysdale Parish, it's ordered the Churchwardens bind out John Frawner son of Edward Frawner.

By consent of the Court, Richard Thilman by indenture binds himself to John Mountague.

Present: Archd. McPherson, Gent.

It's ordered Henry Webster and Ann Oakey be summoned to prove the will of John Gouge.

Ann Eubank and Thomas Eubank's deed to Thomas Fortune was proved by Edmond Pendleton, Francis Taylor and John Pruitt.

Present: John Taylor, Gent.

On the petition of Ann Fletcher, it's ordered Peter Sullinger be summoned to next Court.

It appearing to the Court that Thomas Watts, late guardian to Thomas Riddle, neglects the orphan, by consent of the Court Thomas Riddle makes choice of Edward Herndon to be his guardian.

James Ferguson's deeds of lease and release of land indented to Augt. Leftwich was proved by John Whitlock.

after his time is expired sixteen days, being absent eight days from his service.

Petition. Nathan Chapman agt. William Cockerham. Dismissed, no appearance.

Page 97 [8 July 1748]

Action of trespass on the case. John Cockran of Glasgow agt. Andrew Johnston. Edmond Pendleton Gent. enters himself security for costs and Charles Dick special bail for the defendant.

Action of trespass on the case. Matthew Bogle agt. John Young. Dismissed, being agreed.

Action of debt. David Crosse agt. John Billups. The defendant not appearing, judgment is granted agt. him and Thomas Buckner Gent.; Sheriff, for what shall appear justly due unless the defendant answer the suit.

Petition. John Bowles agt. William Barksdale. Judgment is granted the plaintiff for £1.16.9½ current money.

Action of debt. John Micou Gent. agt. Oliver Towles. Dismissed, being agreed.

Petition. Robert Sanders agt. William Parker. Judgment is granted the plaintiff for £2.15.4.

Action of trespass on the case per slander. Joel Anchrom agt. Daniel Green. Dismissed, being agreed.

Peter Holland acknowledged his deed indented and bond to his son James Holland.

Petition. William Dixon agt. Micajah Pickett and Winney his wife. Judgment is granted the plaintiff for £4 current money.

Action of trespass, assault and battery. John Powell agt. John Pearce. Dismissed, being agreed.

Suit on attachment. Robt. Boyd and William Dunlop, merchants in Glasgow, agt. the estate of Micajah and Winney Pickett. The plaintiff having proved their account, it's considered by the Court they recover £7.8.- current money. The Sheriff made return he had attached one fodder stack. It's ordered he cause the fodder to be sold and satisfy the judgment.

Action of debt. John Harvie merchant agt. Elias Blackburn. The defendant not appearing, judgment is granted agt. the defendant and John Sneed his security for what shall appear justly due unless the defendant answer the suit.

Benja. Hubbard Gent. enters himself security for all the costs in all the suits brought by Thomas Heard, merchant, in this county.

Action on the case. Humphry Bell of London agt. Nicholas Lankford. The defendant not appearing, judgment is granted agt. him and Nicholas Lankford Junr. his security for what damages the plaintiff shall recover unless the defendant answer this action.

Action on the case. Humpy. Bell of London agt. John Watkins. Dismissed, being agreed.

Petition. Humpy. Bell of London agt. David Roberts. Judgment is granted the plaintiff for £2.1.10 current money.

Joshua Mullins by George Wyth his attorney confessed judgment unto Edmond Pendleton quitam in action of debt, for 2000 pounds of tobacco.

Action of debt. Thomas Hamilton agt. John McGrigor. Dismissed, being agreed.

Action of debt. Thomas Hamilton agt. James Robinson. Dismissed, being agreed.

Petition. Humphry Bell of London, merchant, agt. James Turner. Dismissed, being agreed.

Action of trespass on the case. George Buckhannon & c agt. Jas. Martin. Dismissed, being agreed.

Action of trespass on the case. George Buckhannon & c agt. Thomas Bankes. The defendant not appearing, judgment is granted agt. him and Robt. Mickelburrough his security for what damages the plaintiff shall recover unless the defendant answer the suit.

Action of trespass on the case. George Buckhannon & c agt. Joseph Gant. The defendant not appearing, judgment is granted agt. him and John McGrigor his security for what damages the plaintiff shall recover unless the defendant answer the action.

Page 100 [8 July 1748]

Petition. Humphry Bell of London, merchant, agt. John McGrigor. Judgment is granted the plaintiff for £1.6.11½.

Oliver towles and Edmond Pendleton, Gent., confessed judgment unto Zachary Lewis Gent. in action of debt for £80 current money. This judgment to be discharged on the defendant's paying £40 current money with interest from 13 Dec. 1743 until this day.
